## Pedagogy

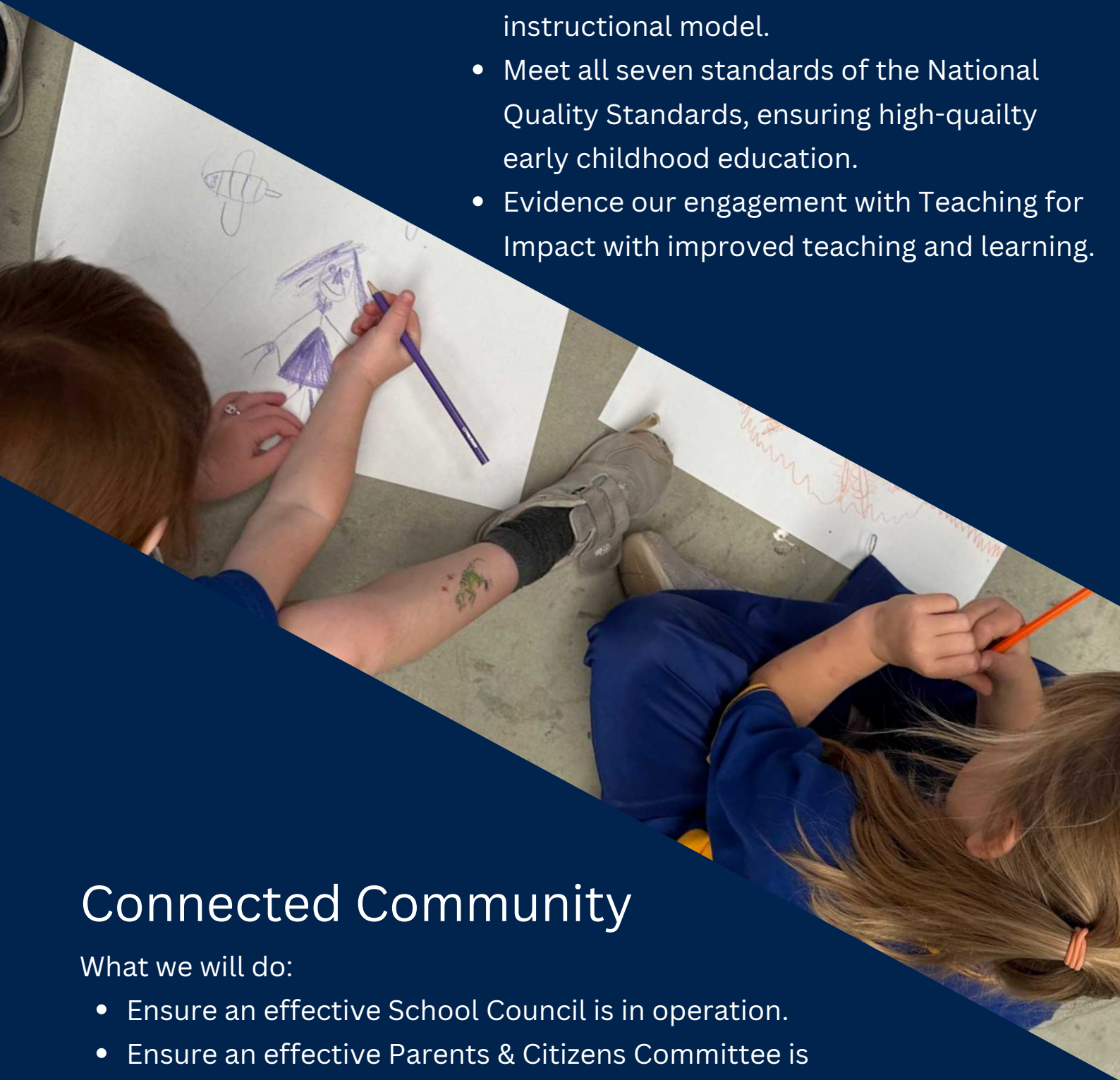
What we will do:
